The UMPO series garnered a huge cult following and has been featured on Access Hollywood, Entertainment Tonight, and The Hollywood Reporter. She co-produced the award-winning West End production of American Idiot in London in 2016. She produced weekly shows for Jeff Goldblum & The Mildred Snitzer Orchestra and Ross Matthews Dragtastic Bubbly Brunch in Los Angeles. As an actor, she has been seen as a guest star on SOUTH PARK. Broadway/NationalTour: South Pacific; Jerry Springer: The Opera (starring Harvey Keitel); The Best Little Whorehouse in Texas (starring Jennifer Hudson) and was a staple of NYC nightlife where she sang in clubs for over a decade. She was a backup singer for Carole King, Melissa Manchester, Rosie O'Donnell, Kristin Chenoweth, and many others. Her current parody, UMPO Jaws at the White Lotus, played Provincetown and Fire Island over the summer and Puerto Vallarta this fall.
